

**TOWN OF JEFFERSON  
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT**

Grace Bull, Clerk of the Town of Jefferson, County of Lincoln, State of Maine:

**GREETINGS:**

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Jefferson in said County and State, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to assemble in the Jefferson Village School in said Town, on Tuesday the 8th day of November, AD, 2022 at eight o'clock in the morning, then and there to act upon Article 1 by written ballot and then upon Article 2 through 4 as set out below by secret ballot. The polling hours will be from eight o'clock in the morning until eight o'clock in the evening.

Pursuant to Title 21-A, Section 759 (7), absentee ballots will be processed at the polls at the following times: 9:00 am, 10:00 a.m., 1:00 p.m., 2:00 p.m. 3:00 p.m., and 6:00 p.m.

Article 1. To elect a moderator by written ballot to preside at said meeting.

Article 2. Shall the Town of Jefferson vote to authorize the select board to enter into multi-year contracts for emergency medical services, on terms as the select board deems in the best interest of the Town; and take from surplus \$20,474.78 to fund emergency medical services for the period July 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022?

Article 3. Shall the Town of Jefferson vote to approve revisions to the Town of Jefferson Shoreland Zoning Ordinance that reflect changes to state-level shoreland zoning rules and regulations (Title 38, sections 435-448)? The Town of Jefferson Shoreland Zoning Ordinance was last revised on March 27, 2012.
