ROAD COMMISSIONER:

- Road Commissioner was not present.

- Route 17 update Pam spoke with DOT and the culverts were delivered on Friday (03/10/23) and were put in place today (03/13/23) and DOT is still on track to finish the repairs by March 24, 2023.

EGYPT ROAD CONTRACT:

• The work hasn't begun yet; the contracts are fully signed. Pam will contact Talia at Hawkes Tree Cutting to get a start date.

CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER:

- Code Enforcement Officer has confirmed he's using the phone provided by the Town.
- Pindo-Polara Road CEO went by to check and see if the work had been completed. There is still no
 water, power or sewer on the property. Lynne to send a letter to the property owner and have them
 attend the April 10th Select Board meeting and explain the status of these issues.

WARRANT:

 During the signing of the Warrant, Pam identified an invoice from Wayne Johnston for labor and machinery for the turnaround on Somerville Road in the amount of \$580. At the December 19, 2022 meeting the Road Commissioner indicated that Somerville had allotted \$3,000 to cover this and the Road Commissioner confirmed this would be sufficient and there would be no additional charges to the Town of Jefferson. Lynne to contact Wayne Johnston to clarify what these invoices were – the check has been held up.
